

## **GALAXY 102**

### **Format Outline**

<b>Station Name</b>	Galaxy 102
<b>Licence Area</b>	Greater Manchester (as defined in licence advertisement)
<b>Frequency</b>	102 MHz
<b>Hours of Broadcast</b>	24 hours a day (locally made at least between 0600-1900 weekdays; and for at least 6hrs on Saturdays and 7hrs on Sundays, predominantly in daytime)

### **Definitions**

<b>Speech</b>	excludes advertising, trails, sponsor credits and the like and will be calculated over the period specified.
<b>Music</b>	percentages are calculated as a percentage of the total tracks broadcast in the specified period.
<b>Peak time(s)</b>	refers to weekday breakfast and afternoon drive output, and weekend late breakfast.
<b>Daytime</b>	is 0600 to 1900 weekdays and 0800 to 1400 weekends.
<b>Locally made</b>	refers to output produced and presented from within the licence area and must include peak time.

### **Character of Service**

**A RHYTHMIC-BASED MUSIC-LED SERVICE FOR 15-29 YEAR-OLDS SUPPLEMENTED WITH NEWS, INFORMATION AND ENTERTAINMENT. THE SERVICE SHOULD HAVE PARTICULAR APPEAL FOR LISTENERS IN THEIR 20s**

### **Detail**

The service will play a mix of contemporary and classic rhythmic music including current and re-current rhythmic hits, dance and club genres such as 'house' and 'garage', soul and r'n'b. Classic tracks will not account for more than 50% of the output. Non daytime will include specialist music programmes which complement the main mix and are of specific appeal to the target audience; such output must account for at least 16 hours a week. Bank holidays/weekends may include specialist or themed programming.

Speech will not exceed 25% of the output but must include a reasonable balance of news and information for the target audience. Local news bulletins will run at least during weekday peaktime. National/regional bulletins will feature at weekends.
